

WATER CONSERVING PLANTS



Water conservation in California is a way of life. Planning for potential future drought when planning our landscapes is practical and sustainable. A drought-tolerant landscape does not have to be dull or arid looking. There are many plants that offer interest with flowers, fruits and colorful foliage. Plants adapted to a Mediterranean climate whether they be Australian, South African, European or native can combine to create a successful whole. Here is a partial list to help you get started. All will do well with little to moderate water. (Moderate meaning less than average). Highly flammable plants such as Juniper, Pine and Eucalyptus and Rosemary (though drought tolerant) have been omitted.
